I am a development focused coach, and I'm looking forward to guiding this team to a second season of continued growth.



We are excited to announce Scott Heasman as our returning Head Coach of our U14 AAA Guelph Jr. Gryphons. Heasman is returning for his second season as the AAA Head Coach of our 2012-born Guelph Jr. Gryphon squad; the team saw a marked improvement under his leadership in 2024/25, and are sitting in sixth place in a competitive OMHA West division at press time.

Prior to his time with GMHA, Heasman was at the helm of a very successful Centre Wellington Fusion squad. Over three years of coaching with Centre Wellington, at the AA and A levels, his teams qualified for the OMHA's each year, and boast two championships. Heasman has spent over a decade in various roles with Centre Wellington Minor Hockey, and was a leader of the Guelph Jr. Gryphons U16 AAA team for the 2009/10 season as an Assistant Coach.

Danny Descary will lead the U14 AA Guelph Jr. Gryphons as Head Coach for the 2025/26 season, after serving as an Assistant Coach with the 2012 born group for the last two years. A highlight from this past season was a strong showing in the Capital Fall Classic, where he helped to lead the Guelph Jr. Gryphons to the finals and one goal away from taking the championship. Prior to his time with the team, Descary has been on the staff of the U14 AAA and U15 AAA teams in recent years.

Coach Descary is a dedicated non-parent coach, focused on developing GMHA players on and off the ice. This will be Descary's fourteenth season behind a Guelph Jr. Gryphon bench. Over that time, he has seen two of his teams qualify for Tri-County finals and has won a total of 8 tournaments, with teams ranging from the U11 to the U16 levels.
