EVALUATIONS EXPECTATIONS

The Mini Gryphon (U7) schedule is currently being populated within the website and will be live mid September. An email will go out once the schedule is updated.

Evaluation Skates – Two Weekends:

Sept 27 & 28: Players will be scheduled by last name to balance ice times. You'll receive an email with your time slot the week before from the Convenor or House League Director. Saturday: skills & drills. Sunday: intersquad games.

Oct 4 & 5: Ice time details will be emailed by Oct 2 as to when to attend. Saturday: drills. Sunday: intersquad games.

Players are to come prepared in full equipment as per Hockey Canada Requirements. Jerseys will be supplied for evaluation purposes and must be returned upon completion of evaluations.

Note: Teams during evaluations are for evaluation only. Friend requests will be considered/added once teams are confirmed for Oct 18.

*Please note: teams will rotate between their designated age group time slots. Example: Team 1 and Team 2 will play at 6:30am week 1 and the 7:30am week 2, on Saturdays, Sundays will also rotate within their timeslots for the year.

*Please note: Dates, times, and locations are subject to change. Please be sure to check your schedule regularly.

REGULAR SEASON SCHEDULE

- Cross ice games start December 14 for the remainder of the season

HOW TO FIND THE EVALUATION SCHEDULE & REGULAR SEASON SCHEDULE ONCE LIVE (mid-September)

- 1. Go to the main page of www.guelphminorhockey.com
- 2. Under the main banner, there is a red banner that outlines all the different divisions within GMHA. Choose MINI GRYPHONS (U6-U9)
- 3. Select your age group
- 4. Scroll down to Calendar and select FULL CALENDAR on the right side just above the Calendar week preview. Here you will see the evaluation ice times, dates and locations as well as the regular season ice times, dates, and locations.
- 5. You can also use TEAM FINDER on the top left side of the website under the OMHA logo and scroll down to ORGANIZATION TOURNAMENTS/TEAMS and select your age group.

IMPORTANT:

- TIMES AND LOCATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE UNTIL THE START OF THE SEASON. SHOULD CHANGES OCCUR, DIVISIONS WILL BE NOTIFIED.
- When bad weather is threatening rink closure please be sure to check emails regularly. We will post on our social media channels as well.
- IF there are no times/places indicated on a Saturday or Sunday, it means you do not have a game/practise on that day.
- There are no playoffs in this age groups

U7 ADP Player Evaluations will begin on September 6th. If you wish to attend, you are required to complete a separate registration from your base season registration. To do this, head to our <u>Player Evaluations Home Page</u> to review the details and complete the registration.

These sessions are completely separate from the House League registration. If your child is successful in making the team, there are further financial and time commitments for the entirety of the season.
